Registration

You can register online or by mail. To pre-register online, please use the form linked on our website mgcamp.com. As part of this form, you will be required to upload a PDF of your MyScouts/iMIS group printout showing all attendees as active or renewed. Online registration is open until the Monday before camp starts. While submissions may still be accepted after this date, they are not guaranteed to be reviewed.

Payment can be made by cheque (mailed in advance or brought to camp) or by cash (at camp only). Mailed registrations, including forms and group lists, must be sent no later than a week before camp.

Activities with Limited Space

Some activities have limited capacity and are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Sign up sheets will be available at camp.

Vehicles

The road is one-way only — do not drive back the way you came. Drive slowly and keep all vehicles on the road, even while unloading. Do not enter camping areas. Park only in designated areas, leaving enough space for other vehicles and emergency access.

Upon arrival, you will be given a card to place on your vehicle's dashboard. Please write your name, group, and phone number on it in case staff need to contact you to move your vehicle.

Camp Law

This is an official Scouting event – all rules, bylaws, policies, and procedures are in effect and will be enforced. Please respect the rules and the staff – it will make the weekend more enjoyable for everyone.

Please bring:

- A current personal health form for each member, kept on their person
- Your MyScouts/iMIS group list as printed from the Scouts Canada or Guides website. (See instructions on our website.)
- An advisor or leader
- Food, shelter, clothing, etc.... water is available onsite, you will have to carry it.
- There is extra emphasis on decorations and costumes! We have prizes for groups who embody the camp's theme.
- All adult members must behave in accordance with the Scouts Canada Code of Conduct at all times.

Leave behind:

- Generators
- Illegal drugs/alcohol/marijuana ZERO TOLERANCE, there will be NO warnings! (0.5% is still alcohol)
- Fireworks / firecrackers / bear bangers / guns / bullhorns / megaphones / air-horns / etc. According to BP&P
- Power tools or air compressors except handheld drills/impact drivers for site setup purposes only

Other notes:

- No fires in Byng's recycling barrels. You will be charged the cost of a barrel if you
 have a fire in one.
- A fire permit must be obtained from HQ prior to lighting. See our website for more information.

Transportation

We've arranged a \$2 round-trip shuttle from the Langdale Ferry Terminal to Camp Byng for those walking on the ferry. There is ample parking at Horseshoe Bay — check the BC Ferries website for more details.)

Please bring \$2 in cash for the shuttle — do not include this with your registration payment. Make sure to indicate on your registration form which ferry you plan to take, so we can ensure enough shuttle space is available.




There will be 2 shuttles to pickup participants at the Langdale ferry terminal on Friday, and 2 shuttles to drop off participants on Sunday. The shuttle is first come-first serve.

Directions for Walk-On Passengers

- By Car: Take Highway 1 Westbound to Horseshoe Bay in West Vancouver. Follow signs to the passenger drop-off area the terminal approach has changed recently.
- By Transit: TransLink buses go directly to Horseshoe Bay. Visit translink.ca for schedules.
- Boarding the Ferry: Make sure to board the Langdale ferry (not Nanaimo or Bowen Island!). The ride is about 40 minutes.
- Arriving at Langdale: Walk to the passenger pick-up area and look for our shuttle greeter. If you're wearing your uniform (which we encourage), we'll spot you easily!
